Step 1 – Adding a hidden field

Go on your Back Office and find your webform in Structure > Webform.
Click on Edit. Click then on Add element and choose a « Hidden » in the Basics elements Tab.

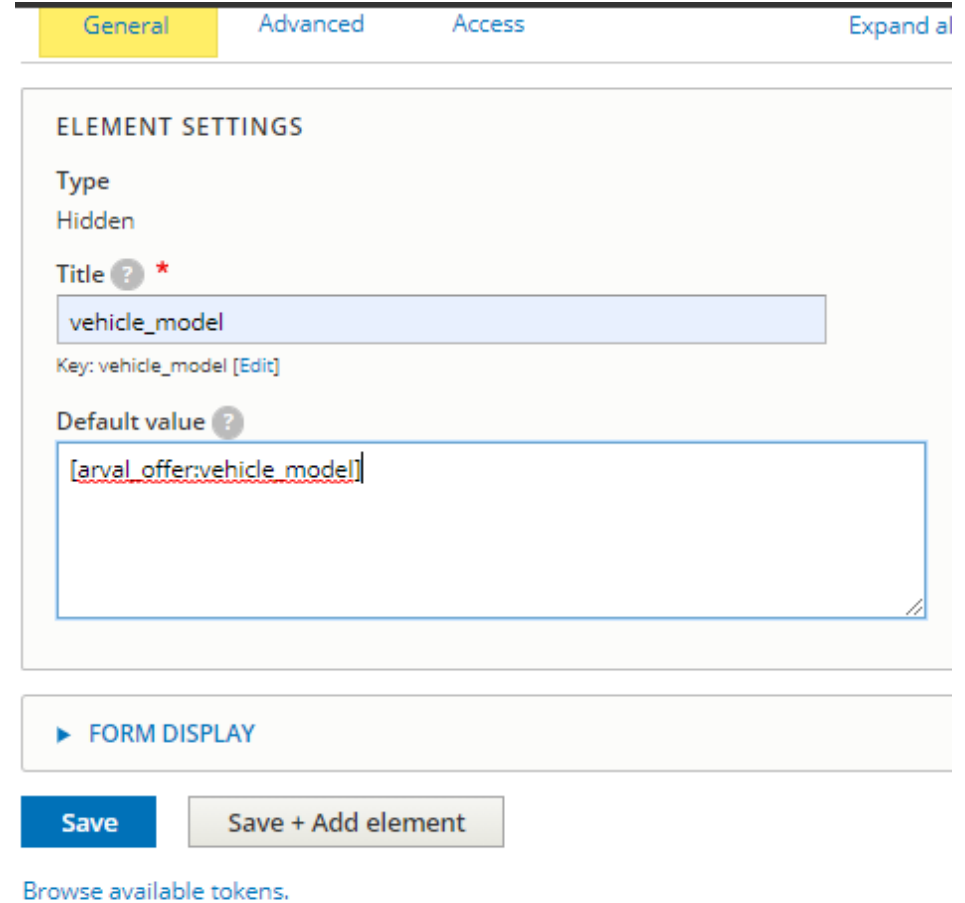
